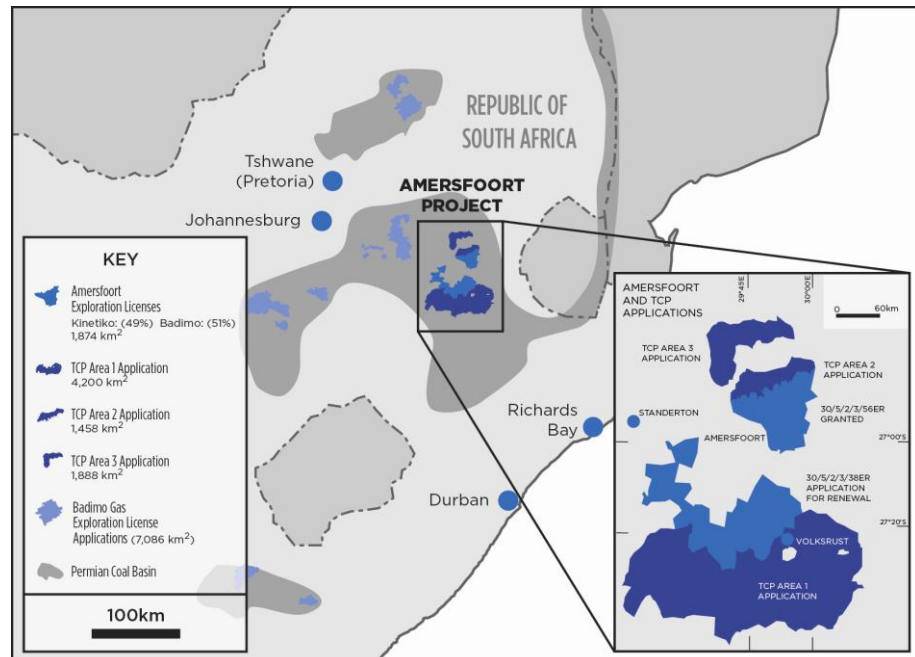
Amersfoort Project

The Amersfoort area of the Eastern Transvaal is one of the most prospective areas for CBM with well documented, gassy coal measures. Kinetiko has 49% equity in 2 onshore gas licenses covering 1,874km² under a Farm Out agreement with a South African company Badimo Gas Ltd, Kinetiko is the Operator.

Independent Oil and Gas consultant: Gustavson Associates of Boulder Colorado have estimated the Amersfoort licenses have CBM Gas In Place (GIP) Resource of 1.7tcf and 1.12tcf Contingent Resource.

The goal of the Amersfoort Exploration program is to increase Resource certainty; this is largely dependent on Exploration success.

- **PASA (Petroleum Agency of South Africa) accepts Kinetiko's third TCP (Technical Commercial Permit) application which covers 1,888Km² of prospective land (TCP Area 3);**
- **This application follows the successful application for TCP Areas 1 and 2 to capture prospective CBM (Coal Bed Methane) structures near the Amersfoort project;**
- **Kinetiko's actual and potential exploration area could now total 9,549Km²;**
- **The application is undergoing assessment and a PASA decision on whether it shall be granted is due within 3-6 months;**
- **If granted, a TCP entitles the holder the exclusive right to apply for and be granted an Exploration Right for the same area;**



Kinetiko has successfully applied for a third Technical Commercial Permit (TCP) – “TCP Area 3”, over a prospective land area (~1,888Km²) north of its existing Amersfoort exploration rights.

Once granted, a TCP entitles the holder up to 12 months to perform desktop studies. It also allows access to existing information and some exploration reconnaissance to assess whether to apply for the land.

The Three Kinetiko TCP applications, if granted, could add 7,675Km² of prospective ground on top of the Company’s existing Amersfoort JV area of 1,874Km².
